WHERE IT ALL BEGAN

Grand Junction is based in a breathtaking Grade I listed building, picturesquely set by the canal side just down from Little Venice in Paddington

Just a 10 minute walk from Paddington Station, beside the Grand Union Canal, St Mary Magdalene Church, also known as Grand Junction, is one of the finest neo-Gothic churches in the country

Grand Junction was built in the 1860s and 70s by the great Victorian architect G E Street, who orchestrated the very best artists and craftsmen to produce a masterwork combining architecture, sculpture, stained glass, and arguably the most remarkable painted ceiling in an English parish church

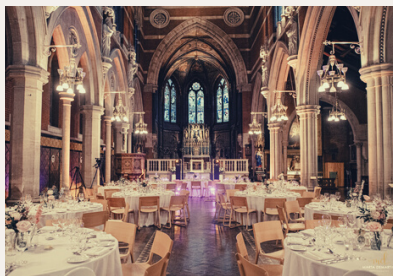
From the mid-20th century the church fell into disrepair but with help from the local community, a loving restoration was granted and Grand Junction was born

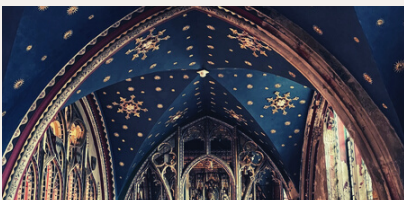
The Nave

FAQ'S

- Warwick Avenue, 0.4m / 8 min walk
- Royal Oak, 0.3m / 7 min walk
- Paddington, 0.9m / 17 min walk

Parking

We suggest that guests make their way to Grand Junction via the excellent transport links or taxi's. Parking is available however limited and subject to availability.

Access Times

Suppliers can have access from 11.30am. Deliveries can be taken by our café team, but confirm this with your event manager. If your event is mid-week, during school term the below times you are unable to unloading /loading including deliveries or collections
Mon - Fri 08:00 - 09:30 and 15:00 - 16:00

Unloading can take place on Rowington Close side of the building. Vehicles cannot obstruct the School Gate or the Vicarage Driveway

Candles

Candles are permitted as long as they are on a base or in a vase

Music & Dancing

As we are in a residential area, we ask that you and your guests respect the our neighbours. Please note that;

- Max 90db with traffic light sound limiter & monitored throughout the evening
- No dancing in the Undercroft
- Live bands are permitted but please no bass

Prohibited Items & Areas

Confetti, Dry Ice, Smoke Machine, Helium Balloons and Sparklers. The use of blue tack, cellotape or any other item that may damage the walls or pillars

The altar, chancel and font are all off limits to clients and guests – your Venue Manager can point these spaces out to you

Evening Prayers

Mon to Fri evening prayers are held in the Nave from 18:00 –18:30. There will be no access to Nave during this time without prior approval
