# Tudor courtyard

Surrounded by diamond-pattern red brick walls, the Tudor courtyard is the perfect setting for cocktails, open-air dinners and evening receptions.

- **Capacities:** 350 seated, 400 standing.
- **Planner guide:** A flexible and atmospheric outdoor heart to the Palace.



## Hidden history

The clock tower, dating back to 1770, still rings hourly, sounding over the area of Fulham.

# The great hall

The oldest and grandest room of the Palace. Its soaring ceiling, oak panels and historic fireplace provide a majestic backdrop for ceremonies, dinners and receptions.

- **Capacities:** 60 seated dinner, 110 standing.
- **Planner guide:** Ideal for winter weddings, dramatic dining or heritage-focused occasions.



## A Royal presence

Queen Elizabeth I, was once a guest at dinner in these rooms.





## Bishop Sherlock's room

Elegant Georgian interiors with Rococo plasterwork, a Steinway piano and garden views. Perfect for intimate weddings, private dinners or breakout sessions.

- **Capacities:** 60 seated, 80 standing.



### From the Archives

The paintings in the room include Bishop Sherlock himself, framed above the fireplace.



### Behind These Walls

This used to be the Bishop's library and included early Agatha Christie novels on its shelves.



## Bishop Terrick rooms

Grand Georgian setting with ornate detailing, high ceilings and views across the gardens to the Tait Chapel. Ideal for wedding ceremonies, private dining or drinks receptions.

- **Capacities:**

- Terrick's drawing room: up to 50.
- Terrick's dining room: up to 30.



# Bishop Tait's chapel

A rare and beautiful private chapel, steeped in centuries of spiritual heritage. An unforgettable setting for blessings, services or musical recitals.

- **Capacity:** up to 90 guests.



## Did you know?

The Chapel plate, dating back to 1653, is now in St Paul's Cathedral.





### Palace secret

The garden once grew prize-winning apricots, dessert apples and strawberries and still grow a whole host of produce today.



## The walled garden



Restored in 2012, the walled garden is London's second oldest botanic garden. Today, the grounds include an orchard, a knot garden and the barrow, selling Palace-grown flowers and produce. From intimate drinks receptions to large-scale parties, the two acres of enclosed garden within 13 acres of landscaped grounds create a magical setting.

- **Capacities:** 500 standing & seated

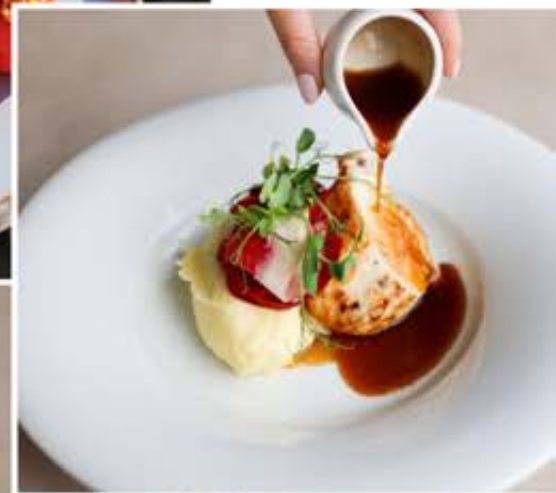
